oo **Charlotte de Campagne**, daughter of **Jeanne Le Prévost** from a prominent family of lawyers and military. Son **Jacques Nicolas**.

## **II. Jacques Nicolas de Boissimène \*c 1668** Paris **+c 1757**. Colonel, Ambassador, Ordre St Louis.

oo 1) **1702.05.20** Brussels **Marie Lemaire** +in childbirth c**1708** Ghent, Belgium, oo 1) **Camille de Valence Sieur de Fontenille**. Having caused his murder she fled to Brussels to escape legal consequence. Son **Antoine**.

oo 2) **1716.05.09** Bayonne **Gracieuse Duvergier Belay \*c 1681, +1753.05.03** Bayonne.

Son **Louis Philippe \*1718.06.24 +1745.12.06** Bayonne. De la Compagnie des Cadets à Rochefort 1737. Godparents were Louis XIV and Philippe V of Spain.

St André +**1804** San Domingo by British troops. Lieutenant in Condé's

oo 2) **1835.05.03** Paris, St Roch «benediction nuptiale» **Placide Alexandre Herson** Inspecteur des Finances. 1 son, 1 daughter.

*The dates of Births, Marriages and Deaths have been difficult to ascertain. Where possible they are noted but the French Revolution, the fires that destroyed most of the parish archives of Paris, and the fact that French Catholic registers in England have not always survived, make the few private reports more important. The name Boissimène appears to be extremely unusual and is often falsely spelled as Boissimenu, Boissiere Boissy et c. I have found only one other family BOISIMENE in 17th century Gironde. They have descendents in Canada.*
